The club's objective is to promote and support the sport of speedskating for recreation as well as competition. Our program is suitable for young children through adult masters level skaters. Many skaters feel this is a sport that spans generations and ability levels--it is truly a sport that can be enjoyed throughout a lifetime at any competitive or fitness level. The Saratoga Winter Club (SWC) is a member of the Northern New York Skating Association, a regional extension of US Speedskating. The SWC is an all-volunteer organization. Skaters and parents of youth skaters are expected to assist with occasional volunteer assignments.

Our Head Coach, Paul Marchese, is a qualified coach, competitor and fitness expert. Together with the parent and adult coaches, they form a cohesive team to ensure that the proper level of instruction is brought to the variety of ability levels our club represents. From novice to Olympian, our coaching staff has something to offer everyone. US Speedskating offers periodic coaching certification clinics in our area for those who wish to assist the coaching staff.

Skaters representing the SWC travel to Calgary, Salt Lake City, Minnesota, and New England states to compete in regional, national and international competitions. Other skaters compete locally in club-sponsored meets in our home rink. The level of competitive involvement is an individual decision and not an obligation imposed by the club.

Our **short track** practices are held at the **Weibel Ave Arena** in Saratoga Springs, NY. Regular season practice is held on **Tuesday** (6-8 pm), **Wednesday** (9-10:30 pm) and **Thursday** (6-8) evenings beginning in October. (Practice times vary slightly during the season) **Long track** practices are held in **Lake Placid, NY** from December thru February. The speedskating season closes at the end of March. Organized summer off-ice workouts are offered as well.
